Lot of ideas!By University DocNot as good as her first book, The Book of Miniatures: Furniture and Accessories, if you're looking for a book on how to make accessories, etc, but if you're a miniaturist aficionado, this is a worthwhile read, just the same. This book focuses on settings for miniature rooms, hence the title. The settings are well detailed. beautiful, charming, realistic. The book, published in 1978 is a bit dated, but still useful, as the settings are not. I would have preferred more color photos than the few dozen included, but if you're into just getting started in the hobby, or just searching for ideas, or just want a good reference book for perusal at your leisure, this wouldn't be a bad book to have on the shelf, just not a great one. This is mainly an idea book with ideas for creating rooms in miniature, rooms done by the author and guest miniaturists. Though, there are some ideas and templates for making some furniture and accessories, if you're looking for a book about making furniture and

accessories, her first book is the way to go. This is worthy of a perusal at least for the photos. There are lots of ideas here. I love her room setting of an artist's studio: Well done and imaginative. If you're into room settings then I highly recommend this book. I agree it is a shame it is out of print. I can only think of some the possibilities an updated edition would make.
