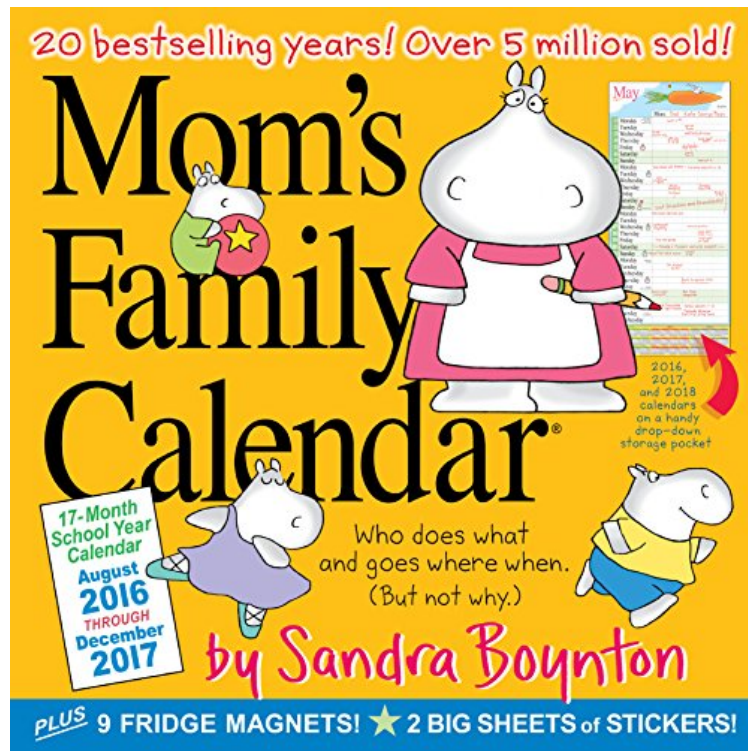

I love it. However, I always have a ton of leftover stickers and they are ALL the same. They have NEVER changed the stickers. Also, the stickers with the activities are ones that don't really apply to us. I think they should have more birthday and vacation stickers than playdate, sleepover, library, haircut, dance class, music lesson, concert, rehearsal, show, company, camp, travel, welcome home- all which my kid (or us) doesn't do. I just this year started using practice and big game as he just started doing soccer. They also need to change the character stickers as they've been the same all these years. The other thing is I like to hang it on the side of the fridge so I can see it everyday. They should include heavy duty magnets with it. I'm in real estate and happened to have leftover magnets from where you can stick a business card on it and make it into a magnet for people. I'm out of them now so I'm going to have to go to the craft store and find some stick on magnets for it. It does get very heavy as

you go through the year so they do need strong or multiple magnets. I do like that it has several columns for several people so you can fit each person's activities for the day. I even add a column for the dog for his vet visits or when he needs a heartworm pill. I don't like the fact that it's a 17 month calendar that starts in July. I didn't buy it in the middle of the year. I never use August-December as I used it on my previous calendar. They should just make it a 12 month calendar!
