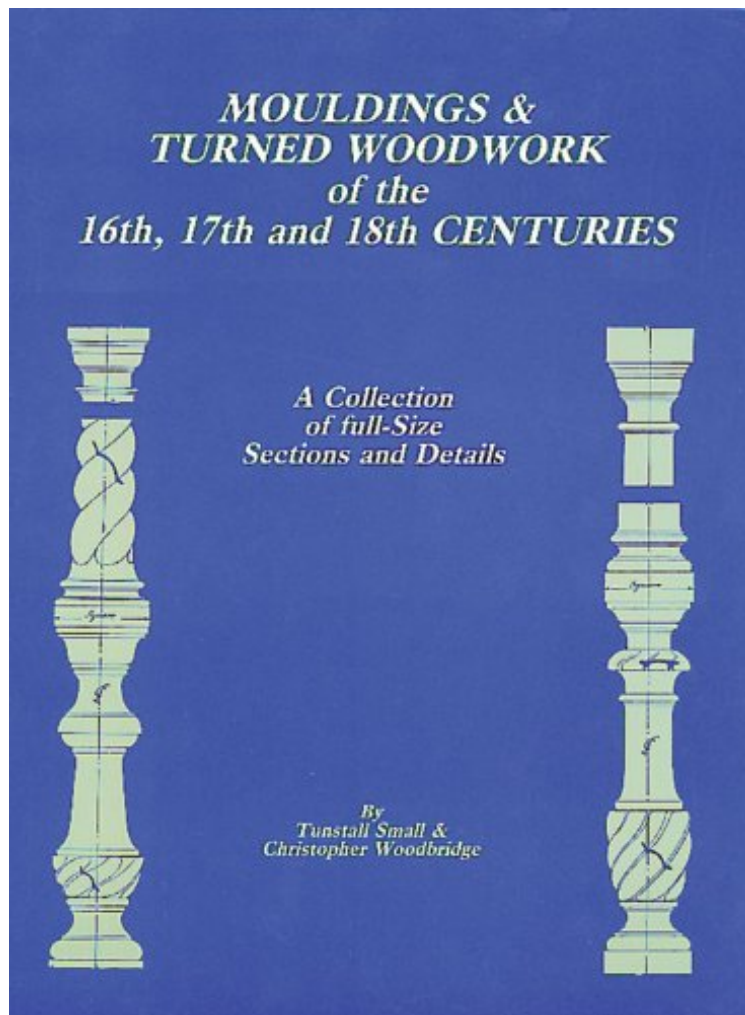

It's ok but the same money will get you a used hard copy, which is far superior.The drawings are fantastic and the dimensioning is better than the latest textbooks on dimensioning drawings. You do have to know how to create

mouldings and use a lathe (for the turned parts), so it's not a beginner book in that sense. But it does provide lots of inspiration and can help you when you're ready to try to make your own mouldings for architectural purposes or for furniture. Even if you're not interested in making mouldings the book serves a reference that's really unique and might help you recognize styles and time periods when something was made. Basically, if you're reading this just go ahead and buy the book. You won't be disappointed.
