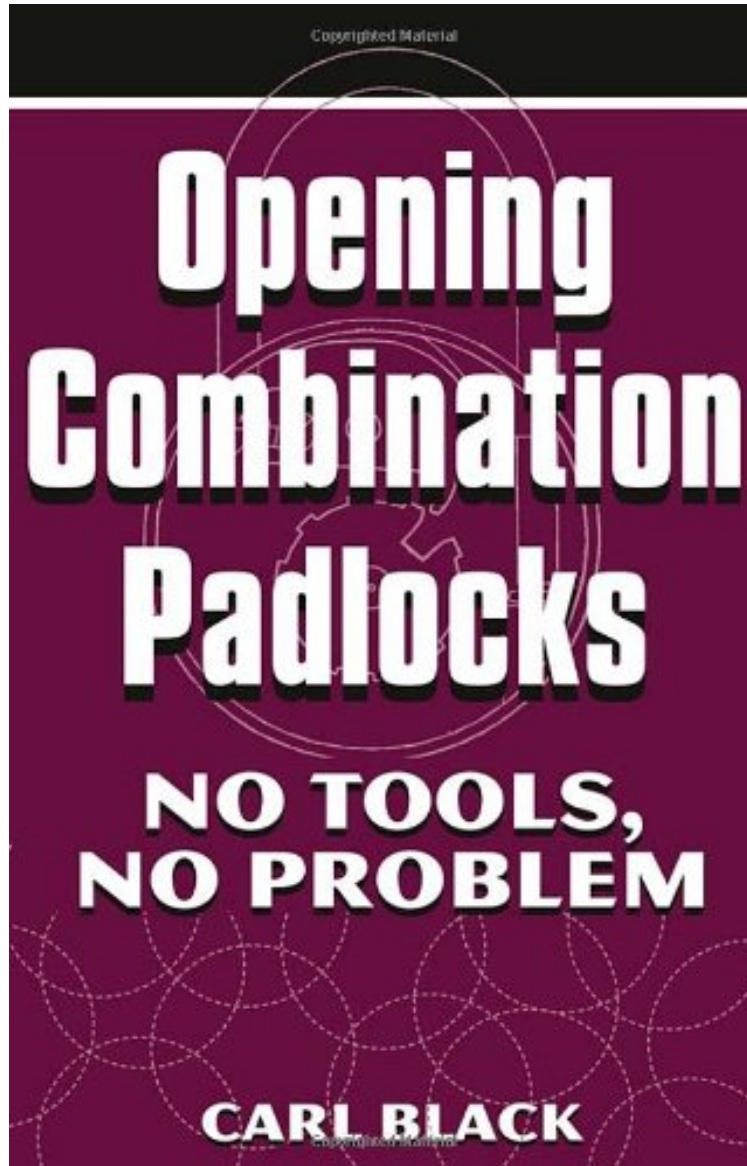

This book just tells you to do exhaustive search, which means it just tells you to try all the combinations. It does point out that each "gate" on a lock is really a range of up to four numbers, and if you pull on the latch you can feel where the gates center. So, now, instead of exhaustive search

taking an amazingly huge amount of time, it instead just takes a huge amount of time. It encourages you to try the most likely combinations first, which is the vast majority of them. Gag. Even if you value your time at minimum wage, you will save money by just BUYING A NEW LOCK, and that's without factoring in the price of this book or how exhaustive search will make your hand hurt. If you think twisting a knob back and forth for hours is fun, and you don't have the minimal brain power to make a table for it (the author says you don't have to understand his tables, and doesn't even mention the shocking ability to keep track of the last three numbers/gates in your head), then this book is for you. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. All this could fit in a web page (and probably does). I don't think it's worth the price.

It is incredibly easy to forget the combination to padlocks on your own tool shed, gym locker or anyplace else these common locks are found. This handy guide teaches one thing: how to open a padlock whose combination is lost. Dissatisfied with books that showed methods that didn't allow entry into all locks or made it difficult to always accurately find the first or third number, usually the main basis for their technique, author Carl Black devised a foolproof system that allows quick entry into all combination padlocks in minutes without any guesswork or tools. He explains how it works with clear instructions and illustrations and gives problem-solving tips for difficult locks. For information purposes only.
