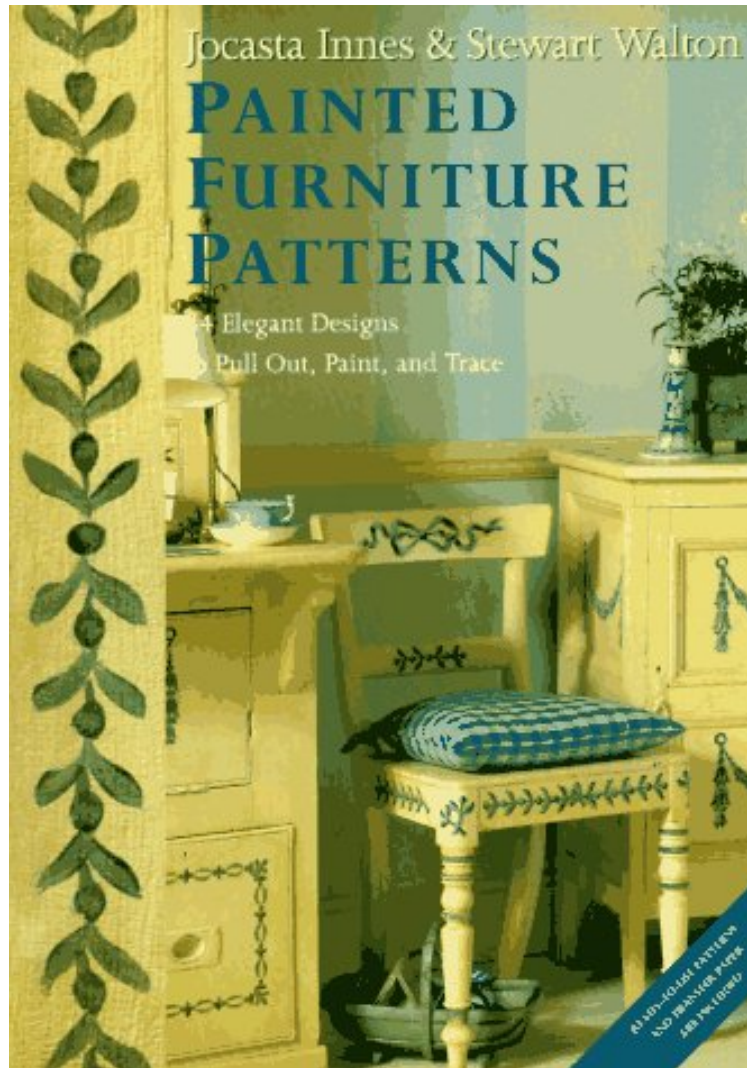

(Stein World, Pulaski, etc.) This book gave me some great details on the type of paints to use and surface prep. I was disappointed that the 32 designs weren't exactly 32 different designs. The book is a compilation of 3 separate books that were originally sold separately with 3 different themes. Each theme has a full array of similar designs that coordinate. Moon and stars designs, floral designs featuring roses, and a more formal design theme with geometric borders, etc. When I painted before these were the types of books I was familiar with at the time, so I could readily see that there were three books that had been combined to make this book. I'd like to find a book with vines and formals other than the rose designs featured in this book. 2 of 2 people found the following review helpful.
