A remarkable writer with extraordinary knowledge of botany. His prose is as delicate and beautiful as the trees and flowers he describes. He often illustrates his own work with exquisite drawings. Pastoral Days is rich with detail. Gibson was also an early ecologist as he seeks to connect insect and plant life, to explain habitat and to make Darwin's work intelligible in the late 19th century. Most appealing is his interest in the local and everyday experience of nature. My sense in reading Gibson was that I had rediscovered a master whose work needs to be more widely known and celebrated.
